More specifications are being written that require installers to be ACI Flatwork Certified. The American Concrete Institute (ACI) Flatwork Finisher Certification is a nationally recognized program that is a requirement for many national specifications and we foresee many local projects to require this in 2014.

Course Overview

The Flatwork Finisher Certification program was designed to certify experienced concrete finishers and upgrade the quality of concrete construction.

Certification consists of passing a 50 question written exam and providing documentation of at least 4,500 hours of finishing experience. Finishers with less than 4,500 hours experience that pass the written exam will qualify as "Flatwork Technicians".
