BUILD WITH STRENGTH

No other material can replicate concrete's advantages in terms of strength, durability, safety and ease of use. In April, 2016 NRMCA launched Build with Strength, a coalition of architects, builders, engineers, emergency services personnel and policymakers, with a mission to educate the building and design communities and policymakers on the benefits of ready mixed concrete, and encourage its use as the building material of choice for low-to mid-rise structures. The Coalition's plan will be presented, including the 7 steps you can take to become engaged in its success.

FMCSA REGULATIONS / HOURS OF SERVICE

Over the past 9 years there has been an unprecedented number of regulations that have been promulgated by the federal government. Many of these newly finalized and proposed rules have come from the U.S. Department of Transportation (DOT), particularly from the DOT agency known as the Federal Motor Carrier Safety Administration (FMCSA). FMCSA oversees regulations surrounding commercial motor vehicles (CMVs), such as ready mixed concrete trucks. These regulations include driver's Hours of Service (HOS), Electronic Logging Devices (ELDs), Sleep Apnea, CMV Insurance and Speed Limiters, just to name a few. If you're unclear about what these regulations are or how they'll impact your business, this session will fill in those blanks.

WORKFORCE DEVELOPMENT

The ready mixed concrete industry is challenged, not only hiring and keeping mixer drivers, but across the board in many job categories. NRMCA and state associations have been working on programs for producers to use that illustrate, to current and future employees that the industry provides more than a job—it provides a career. Hear the results from NRMCA's driver recruitment and retention survey that compares the South Central region to the rest of the country. Additionally, hear what state associations are doing to support their membership on a local basis.

RESULTS OF THE 2016 NRMCA INDUSTRY DATA SURVEY
